

IMMACULATE CONCEPTION


The Immaculate Conception (a Holyday of Obligation) is a Catholic dogma that states that Mary, whose conception was brought about the normal way, was conceived without original sin or its stain. That's what "immaculate" means: without stain.

The essence of original sin consists in the deprivation of sanctifying grace, and its stain is a corrupt nature. Mary was preserved from these defects by God's grace; from the first instant of her existence she was in the state of sanctifying grace and free from the corrupt nature original sin brings.

The phrase "full of grace" is a translation of the Greek word *kecharitomene*. It expresses a characteristic quality of Mary. So the grace Mary enjoyed extended over the whole of her life, from conception onward. She was in a state of sanctifying grace from the first moment of her existence. 
