



Rosary Rally



Women's Bible Study



The Bible study will take women on an exciting journey closer to the heart of God. Women use a guide book containing 22 lessons in combination with a Bible. There are a few different opportunities for attending bible study to accommodate schedules; Sunday afternoon 4:00 pm—5:30 pm in the Parish Center; or Tuesday evening 7:30 pm—9:00 pm in a home setting. *Groups meet twice a month.* The groups will begin to meet the week of September 22nd.

Here is what one woman had to say about her experience with this year's Bible Study:

"I have truly enjoyed getting to know so many women in the parish. I know I have grown in my faith and have learned a lot during these sessions, which is amazing! I've heard many stories of ordinary people proclaiming that "their prayers have been answered" and to be honest I often thought "why doesn't that happen to me." Through our bible study lessons, I came to realize that I avoided truly asking God for specific things for fear He may not answer me and then I'd feel I'm not important enough for God to listen to. In lesson four we learned that God wants us to pray to Him with big, bold prayers for things we can't accomplish on our own. He wants us to confidently rely on Him to help us. At the end of the lesson, we learned that God is always listening and He knows what is best for us and how and when our prayers need to be answered. Shortly after discussing the lesson with our small group I found myself frustratingly trying to pray for someone, but I couldn't remember his name. The teen suffers from chronic migraines that are so bad he can't attend school like everyone else. I prayed for this boy during bedtime prayers with my kids, but kept referring to him as "that boy" and tried my hardest to remember his name. Finally, I decided to ask God to help me and much to my surprise, a name came to me immediately, Lewis! I wasn't confident I had the right name, but after verifying with my mom, I knew God had been listening to me. I still pray that God heals Lewis...in His perfect timing."
