

## From Fr. Brian



Que tal? Hi from Bolivia. I am in the Diocese of San Ignacio de Velasco. The see is six hours from Santa Cruz.

So far I've been riding along with Bishop Robert Flock and learning about the local church. Five of us packed into the Bishop's jeep, we traveled last Sunday to the furthest end of the diocese near the Brazilian border. He had three masses to install two new pastors. One is leading two parishes.

Monday was more relaxed. We were able to do some touring and hiking. Tuesday, the Bolivian Air Force flew us to a remote place for Confirmation and first communion at two parishes. I've just been taking in as much as I can handle and listening.

The large part of this diocese serves la Chiquitanía. It is a low lying tropical part of Bolivia with beautiful native culture interwoven with deep Catholic faith. The region was evangelized by the Jesuits, who were expelled in 1767, as they were from all Spanish lands. Local clergy filled in for a while until Franciscan missionaries were sent. Now the diocese of Santa Cruz staffs these parishes.

I miss Cottage Grove and I will see you all next Sunday. I wish I could be there for the picnic, but my trip was booked before I was given the date for the picnic. Enjoy! I will have more to share next week.

## Rosary Rally


