

Christian Prevention and Relationship Enhancement Program 2017

Based on research at the University of Denver started in 1980, the CPREP Approach is a program designed by experts to help couples build lasting, loving relationships and prevent divorce. The clinically tested techniques are for any couple—from the nearly engaged to the long-time partners—who want to solve problems or prevent them from happening. It's for people who want to improve their marital communications.

The 6-classes/12 hour program will be held on the following SATURDAYS from 2 to 4 pm:
