The New Testament and the Sacrament of Matrimony

Jesus taught the original of the union of man and a woman as God willed it from the beginning Matthew 19: 4-6 and the permission given by Moses to divorce one's wife was a concession of the hardness of heart of man in Matthew 19:8.

He said in reply, "Have you not read that from the beginning the Creator 'made them male and female and said, 'For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh?' So they are no longer two, but one flesh. Therefore, what God has joined together, no human being must separate." (Matthew 19: 4-6)

The whole of a Christian carries of the symbol of the love of Christ to his Church. The Sacrament of Matrimony is an efficacious sign, the sacrament that binds Christ and the Church. Thus it symbolizes and it is an instrument of grace, the union between two baptized persons are truly a sacrament of the New Covenant.
