

FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT NOVEMBER 30 - DECEMBER 1,2019

Today we enter into a new season of Advent, a season of waiting - waiting for the coming of the Lord, the Lord of peace, joy and light. It's waiting that recalls His coming in the past as Son of Mary and Joseph in human form; and His future second coming as the Lord to be encountered in our present times. In the readings, we are reminded how important it is for us to prepare for this coming of Jesus. As the prophet says we are invited to a journey to climb the mountain of life to the eternal presence of the Lord Who offers salvation for us all. Let's prepare our hearts for His birth through cleansing of our lives and letting go of our old ways of grudge, immorality, hypocrisy and hatred. May the Holy Spirit touch our hearts to make an internal journey in this season of Advent and prepare our hearts for His birth by being alert, awake and by cultivating a life of charity and virtue. May our Lady of Good Counsel intercede for us.

SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING!!!

Protecting God's Children

The Office of Safe Environment is responsible for implementing and overseeing the full Diocesan response to the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People (The Charter). By providing online and in-person educational training programs, presentations and resource materials, we are able to assist church personnel in responding to the mandates of The Charter. In addition, this office organizes the annual audits required by The Charter and, with the offices of Human Resources, and Clergy, oversees background_screening of adults who have ongoing, unsupervised contact with minors, and the internal investigation process relating to child abuse allegations involving church personnel.

If you are a part of any ministry that has unsupervised contact with children, you are required to take the Safe Environment Training which includes a background check..

In addition to the Diocese requirements, Our Lady of Good Counsel has determined that <u>ALL VOLUNTEERS</u> will need to complete the Safe Environment Training. To ensure full compliance, and to accommodate work schedules, Our Lady of Good Counsel is offering Safe Environment Classes on the following dates at times. To register, please go to the Virtus website at <u>www.virtus.org</u>.

- 2. Sign up for one of the classes that will be provided at OLGC by Tyra Lamb.
- 3. If you are unable to attend a live class, you can opt to take the class online at www.virtus.org
- 4. When you have completed the training, provide a copy of your training certificate to the office.



In his homily, Bishop Silva said that "if we want to restore true authority so that our culture can live in peace and harmony, then we have the best teacher before us. Christ, the One Who exercises His greatest authority as our King and Who teaches us not only by His Word but by His example what it means to humbly serve, be honest, be forgiving, and to live so that the kingdom of justice, peace and love can be proclaimed."

After the Mass, there was to be a procession around the church but due to the weather, the Benediction was held inside the church. After Bishop Silva read a reading from the gospel and said a prayer, five separate readings were done by various people representing different ministries. The five stations were represented by Tyra Lamb & SheMarion Lamb-Price (Adorers), Jena Orcini (Blessed Mother's Prayer Group), the Wenceslao family (Youth), Pat & Clay Pait (Perpetual Adorers of the Blessed Sacrament) and the Antonio Family (Altar Servers).

Once the Benediction was done, everyone was invited to attend a special dinner and fellowship in the Pastoral Center. Over a hundred people joined PABS to have good food and enjoy each other's company. Many thanks to all who helped to prepare for this event and all who ensured that everything from the Mass, Benediction and dinner went smoothly. Thanks to Rose Daguio and the Fellowship Ministry for setting up the Pastoral Center, arranging for the catered food, serving and cleaning up.
