His priest went also and argued: "He was not really a bad guy, let him have another chance!" Many other friends of his went also and pleaded with Satan saying: "Let him out, please!" The gates remained stubbornly shut against all their voices. Finally his mother came, she did not beg for his release. Quietly, and with a strange catch in her voice, she said to Satan, "Let me in." Immediately the great doors swung open upon their hinges. For love goes down through the gates of hell and there redeems the damned.

A while back in this column I considered how we should react when some of our loved ones cease externally to practice as Christians. I suggested that because of the power given us by the incarnation ("Whosoever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven. Whose sins you shall forgive they are forgiven"), our

love and forgiveness binds our loved ones to the Body of Christ and forgives them, even if externally they have wholly or partially severed their relationship to church. Among other things, I stated no one can go to hell if they are loved by someone within the Body of Christ, providing they do not actively reject that love. I have received a lot of reaction, emotional and reflective, positive and negative.

Cristo Todavía Tiene Carne Humana

Un hombre muy descuidado de las cosas espirituales murió y fue al infierno. Sus viejos amigos lo extrañaban mucho en la tierra. Su agente de negocios bajó a las puertas del infierno para ver si había alguna posibilidad de traerlo de regreso. Pero, aunque pidió que se abrieran las puertas, las barras de hierro nunca cedieron. Su sacerdote también fue y le dijo: "¡Él realmente no es un mal hombre, dale otra oportunidad!" Muchos otros de sus amigos también fueron a rogarle a Satanás diciendo: "¡Déjalo salir, por favor!" pero las puertas permanecieron cerradas a todas las voces. Finalmente llegó su madre, ella no rogó por su liberación. Suavemente, y con una extraño tono en su voz, le dijo a Satanás: "Déjame entrar." Inmediatamente las puertas se abrieron. El amor baja por las puertas del infierno y redime a los condenados.

Tiempo atrás en esta columna pensé en cómo debemos reaccionar cuando algunos de nuestros seres queridos dejan de practicar como cristianos. Sugerí que por el poder que nos ha dado la encarnación ("Todo lo que ates en la tierra será atado en el cielo, cuyos pecados perdones serán perdonados"), nuestro amor y perdón une a nuestros seres queridos al Cuerpo de Cristo y los perdona, aunque hayan cortado total o parcialmente su relación con la iglesia. Entre otras cosas, he dicho que nadie puede ir al infierno si ellos son amados por alguien dentro del Cuerpo de Cristo, con tal de que no rechazan activamente ese amor. Recibí mucha reacción, emocional y reflexiva, positiva y negativa.

For instance, a letter to the editor warned: "The Bible tells us that Jesus, the Lamb of God, takes away the sins of the world. The Bible does not tell us that we will be saved by accepting the love from someone in the Body of Christ. 'Jesus is the only way to salvation ... if you do not believe in the Son of God, you will not have eternal life with God but you will go to hell (no matter who loves you)'." Another lady writes: "I firmly believe that, when we pray for the salvation of our loved ones, they will be saved—but because the Holy Spirit leads them to repent and not because we love them and somehow can expiate their sinfulness on our own. 'Love does cover a multitude of sins, but the sins covered are our own, not those of others!'" These critiques, as they are written, are wholly correct. I have only admiration both for the instinct behind them and for their actual phrasing. I do not for one second dispute that it is only Christ, the Holy Spirit and personal repentance that can save. What I do dispute is the parameters within which these realities are often understood. Let me explain.

Only Christ saves, admittedly. But where is the reality of Christ? Was the incarnation only a 33-year experiment, a one-shot incursion by God into human history? No! The marvel of the mystery is that God took on human flesh and has never since ceased to have human flesh. In St. Paul's words, "We are the body of Christ." We don't replace Christ's historical body, we are not like his body, nor are we even his mystical body, we are his body; flesh, blood, tangible, in history, and to the extent that we live in grace, the on-going incarnation, God in flesh in history.

There is a marvelous story told about a four-year-old child who awoke one night frightened. In the darkness he imagined all kinds of spooks and monsters in his room. In fear he got up and ran to his parents' bedroom. His father calmed him and, taking him back to his own room, put on a light and reassured him with the words: "You needn't be afraid. God is here in the room with you!" The child replied: "*I know God is here, but I want someone here who has some skin!*" God knows we need him in more than the abstract. We need skin! That is why he chose to become incarnate in it. But he didn't shed his earthly skin after 33 years; once enfleshed, he has remained in skin. We are his body now. When we forgive, Christ is forgiving; when we bind, Christ is binding; when we console, Christ is consoling. When we suffer anguish over a loved one, the lamb of God is bleeding.

When people accept our love, they are accepting Christ's love. When their hearts are warmed and moved because we love them, they are being moved, and repentance is taking place, through Christ and the Holy Spirit. That is the mystery of the incarnation! It is true! Nobody can go to hell if they are loved by someone within the Body of Christ, providing they do not actively reject that love. Does this all sound incredible? I hope so because then maybe we will begin to see the tip of the iceberg: the huge mysterious, powerful, earthly and incredible mystery of the incarnation. One lady wrote to me saying: "I would love to believe you, but it just seems too good to be true!" What a marvelous description of the incarnation!

Por ejemplo, una carta a mi editor advirtió: "La Biblia nos dice que Jesús, el Cordero de Dios, quita el pecado del mundo.

La Biblia no nos dice que seremos salvos al aceptar el amor de alguien en el Cuerpo de Cristo. "Jesús es el único camino para la salvación; .. si no crees en el Hijo de Dios, no tendrás vida eterna con Dios, sino que irás al infierno (no importa quién te ame)". Otra señora escribió: "Creo firmemente que cuando oramos por la Salvación de nuestros seres amados, ellos serán salvos—pero porque el Espíritu Santo los lleva al arrepentimiento y no porque los amemos y de alguna manera podamos expiar su pecados por nuestra cuenta". Y "El Amor cubre una multitud de pecados, pero los pecados que cubre son los nuestros, no los de los demás!"

Estas críticas, tal como están escritas, son muy ciertas. Sólo tengo admiración tanto por su carácter y sus palabras. Ni por un segundo cuestiono eso, sólo Cristo, el Espíritu Santo y el arrepentimiento personal pueden salvar. Lo que cuestiono son los parámetros dentro de los cuales estas realidades son muchas veces entendidas.

Permítanme explicar.

Sólo Cristo salva. Pero, ¿Dónde está la realidad de Cristo? ¿Acaso la encarnación fue solamente un experimento de 33 años? ¡No! La maravilla del misterio es que Dios se hizo carne humana y desde entonces nunca dejó de tener carne humana. En las palabras de San Pablo: "Nosotros somos el Cuerpo de Cristo". No reemplazamos al cuerpo histórico de Cristo, no somos como su cuerpo, ni somos su cuerpo místico, somos su cuerpo; carne, sangre, tangible, en la historia, y en la medida en que vivimos en la gracia, la encarnación en curso, Dios en carne en la historia.

Hay una historia maravillosa de un niño de cuatro años de edad, que despertó una noche asustado. En la oscuridad imaginaba todo tipo de fantasmas y monstruos en su habitación. Con miedo, se levantó y corrió a la habitación de sus padres. Su padre lo calmó y, llevándolo de regreso a su propia habitación, prendió una luz y lo tranquilizó con las palabras: "No tienes que tener miedo. Dios está aquí en la habitación contigo" "El niño respondió: ¡Yo sé que Dios está aquí, pero quiero a alguien aquí con un poco de piel."

Dios sabe que lo necesitamos más que en lo casual. Necesitamos a alguien con piel! Por eso eligió encarnarse. Pero él no derramó su piel terrenal después de 33 años. Una vez encarnado, ha permanecido en la piel. Ahora somos su cuerpo. Cuando perdonamos, Cristo es quien perdona; Cuando atamos, Cristo esta atando; Cuando consolamos, Cristo esta consolando. Cuando sufrimos la angustia de un ser amado, el cordero de Dios está sangrando.

Cuando la gente acepta nuestro amor, ellos están aceptando el amor de Cristo. Cuando sus corazones son motivados porque los amamos, están siendo motivados y el arrepentimiento está ocurriendo a través de Cristo y del Espíritu Santo. ¡Ese es el misterio de la encarnación! ¡Es verdad! Nadie puede ir al infierno si son amados por alguien dentro del Cuerpo de Cristo, siempre que no rechacen activamente ese amor.

¿Todo esto suena increíble? Lo espero porque entonces tal vez podamos comenzar a ver la punta de la bola de hielo: el enorme misterio, poderoso, terrenal e increíble misterio de la encarnación. Una señora me escribió diciendo: "Me encantaría creerte, pero parece demasiado bueno para ser verdad!"
