

Little Portion Food Pantry

328 W. Davis Street, Burlington (across the street from our present pantry).
 One side of the building is Centro La Comunidad (Catholic Charities). The other side, (facing S. Fisher), is the front of our pantry Little Portion Food Pantry

We have distribution two times a month. You may visit our pantry one time a month. We plan to continue to have fresh produce, potatoes, meat, and bread plus a box of staples. Distribution will be the second Monday of the month from 10:30am - 1:30pm, and the fourth Monday of the month from 1:30pm - 4:30pm.

In order to have enough fresh produce and potatoes for each distribution, we encourage you to do the following: if you usually come to the pantry in the morning, come to the second Monday distribution. If you usually visit the pantry in the afternoon, go to the fourth Monday of the month.

La despensa se está localizada en 328 W. Davis Street, Burlington (al otro lado de la calle de nuestra actual despensa). Un lado del edificio es Centro La Comunidad (Caridades Católicas). El otro lado, (viendo a la calle S. Fisher), es el frente de nuestra despensa de Comida la Pequeña Porción.

Tenemos distribución dos veces al mes. Usted puede visitar nuestra despensa una vez al mes. Continuaremos teniendo productos frescos, papas, carne, y pan, más una caja de alimentos básicos. La distribución será el Segundo lunes del mes de 10:30am-1:30pm, y el cuarto lunes del mes de 1:30pm-4:30pm.

Para tener suficientes productos frescos y papas para cada distribución, le pedimos hacer lo siguiente. Si normalmente viene a la despensa por la mañana, venga a la distribución del segundo lunes del mes. Si normalmente visita la despensa por la tarde venga al cuarto lunes del mes.

Preparation for Sacraments:

Sacramental Preparation is a **TWO-YEAR** process. A child may begin the process as early as first grade which will count as Year One. Preparation for First Reconciliation and First Communion is comprised of learning about our Catholic faith in our **Religious Education program** plus, during their Year TWO of preparation, they will begin their immediate Sacramental Preparation to celebrate First Reconciliation (Confession) and then First Eucharist using family *Growing Up Catholic* workbooks.

Year TWO Children preparing for **First Reconciliation and First Communion** must first be registered for and attending Sunday morning Religious Education at Blessed Sacrament.

One-hour sessions with your Sacramental Preparation workbooks will be offered on Wednesday evenings at the Our Lady of the Angels Center (408 West Davis Street, Burlington) on dates according to your schedules which will be given out at the Parent information meeting on:

September 23, 2025 from 6PM-7PM in English at the Church (1620 Hanford Road, Graham).

Preparación para los Sacramentos:

La preparación sacramental es un proceso de **DOS AÑOS**. Un niño puede comenzar el proceso desde el primer grado, lo cual cuenta como el **AÑO UNO**. La preparación para la Primera Reconciliación y la Primera Comunión consiste en aprender sobre nuestra fe católica en nuestro programa de **Educación Religiosa**. Además, durante el **AÑO DOS** de preparación, comenzarán su preparación sacramental inmediata para celebrar la Primera Reconciliación (Confesión) y luego la Primera Eucaristía utilizando los cuadernos de ejercicios familiares de *Creciendo en la Fe Católica*.
