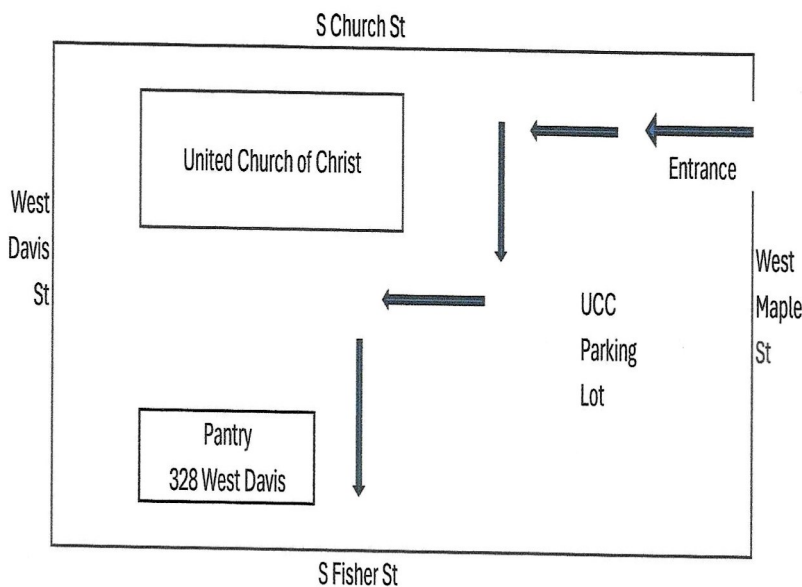

The Little Portion Food Pantry is located at 328 W. Davis Street, Burlington. We have distribution two times a month. You may visit our pantry one time a month. We plan to continue to have fresh produce, potatoes, meat, and bread plus a box of staples. Distribution will be the second Monday of the month from 10:30am - 1:30pm, and the fourth Monday of the month from 1:30pm - 4:30pm.

In order to have enough fresh produce and potatoes for each distribution, we encourage you to do the following: **if you usually come to the pantry in the morning, come to the second Monday distribution. If you usually visit the pantry in the afternoon, go to the fourth Monday of the month.**

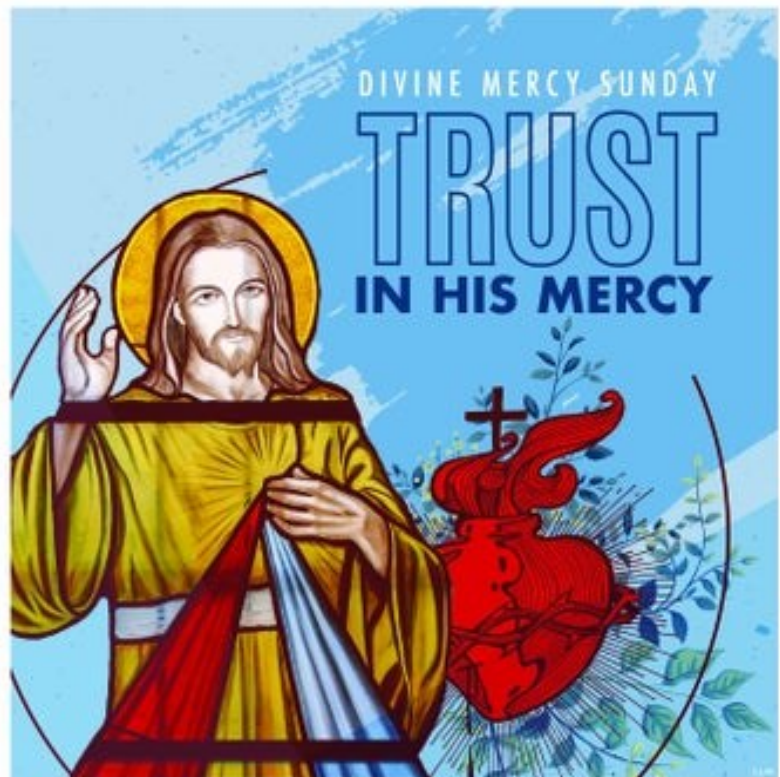
Gospel:
