Teens will not have access to their phones until after the retreat has concluded and pick-up begins at 8:00pm. This will be the case for all teens unless this form is submitted to me by the morning of the retreat.

Teens exempt from this policy include:

- Those with serious medical (physical or mental health) conditions that may require them to contact parents quickly
- Those who have designated some other *valid reason* for needing to keep their phone on their person for the duration of the retreat. Said reasons must be communicated to Hannah via email (hannah@blessedsacramentnc.org) by Friday February 20th.

For teens who are able to keep their phone with them, they may not use them except in the cases specified. It is our goal to create a focused and prayerful environment during our time together this Saturday!
