THE SPIRITUAL BATTLE CONTINUES AS DOES THE CIVIL BATTLE:

SPIRITUAL: On June 6, 2006 (6-6-6) twelve hours of the FIRST EVER Green Bay 40 Days for Life vigil was covered in prayer by our two parishes, Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary (St. Mary) and St. Michael the Archangel. That abortion facility closed permanently seven years later. As Deacon Randy Meidl pointed out, the U.S. Supreme Court decision that overturned federal abortion laws was released on June, 24, 2022 (June = 6, 2+4=6, 2+0+2+2=6). Revelation 13.18 reveals the number of "the beast" as 666.

CIVIL: On Sat. June 25, 2022 Gov. Evers declared that if doctors are prosecuted under Wisconsin's 1849 abortion law, he'll offer them clemency. On Tuesday, June 28, 2022, WI Governor Tony Evers and Attorney General Josh Kaul challenged the state's 19th century state law banning most abortions in the wake of the overturning of Roe v. Wade with a new lawsuit that asks state courts to clarify whether the 173-year-old ban is still in place.

EPHESIANS 6.12 teaches us "our struggle is not with flesh and blood but with the principalities, with the powers, with the world rulers of this present darkness, with the evil spirits in the heavens." We are in spiritual warfare with Satan and his demons, not human beings. We must pray for people who have fallen into the temptations of Satan and hope they will accept the redemption Jesus Christ offers EVERYONE.
