From the Grapevine by Deacon Randy J

In this weekend's gospel, Jesus enters the temple in Jerusalem to prepare for Passover. The temple was built as a place for the Jews to encounter God. Instead, a portion of the temple was turned into a marketplace where the selling of animals and birds took place. Distraught over this use of the temple, Jesus drives out the money changers and the animals. This event is often referred to as the cleansing of the temple.

Our bodies and souls are called our spiritual temples, and we are asked to keep our temples holy. We can accomplish this by keeping the commandments that God presented to Moses (as written in today's reading from Exodus). Each commandment begins, "You shall," which means "You must" (it is mandatory). But through our sinfulness, we do not keep our temples holy. Lent is a good time to cleanse our temple and purify ourselves. This is done through the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

In the Book of James (4:7-8) it is written, "So submit yourselves to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. Draw near to God and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners and purify your hearts, you of two minds." Let us heed the words of St. James, cleanse our temples, and draw closer to God this Lent!
