The Holy Season of Advent is an invitation to the whole world to do exactly what our Patron invites us to do in his first homily as pope,

to "open wide the doors for Christ", Christ who came to us in the manger of Bethlehem, comes to us today in the life of His Grace, and will come again in glory at the end of time to inaugurate a New Heaven and a New Earth.

Christ comes to us, but "when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?" (Lk 18:8b) By our prayer, penances, self-denial, and generosity during this Holy Season we prepare for His coming among us and welcome Him with hearts that long for His salvation for ourselves, our family, our nation, and our world. Remember, the best way to prepare for Christmas on December 25 is to commit to Advent until December 24. Holy Mother Church knows what we need and has given us a full Season of Advent that lasts until the Christmas Season begins on December 25 and ends with the Baptism of the Lord. As the school year began, I invited everyone to participate in the work of building a Catholic culture together here at JPG by the cultural commitments of **discipleship**, a

culture of life, integral knowledge, and conversion. This Advent, I would like to renew my invitation with an emphasis on our commitment to discipleship. We are a school on a mission to "promote the sacred traditions of the Roman Catholic Church." (JPG Mission) The foundation of our mission is "the one thing necessary" (Lk 10:42), an active relationship with Jesus Christ as the Lord and Master of our lives. Our school's mission cannot be accomplished unless it is the Lord who "builds our house", and we would labor in vain unless we labor to accomplish His Will for us and our school. (Ps 127:1) The life we share through accomplishing our mission together should makes it easier for us to be better disciples, better students (discipuli in Latin) of Christ the Teacher. The most important thing for all of us is God's Will for our lives and we should be committed to helping others find His Will and live it with courage. The door for Christ MUST be wide open at JPG! To this end, I ask every one of us to journey together this Advent Season as disciples of the Lord in a specific way. Choose a small group of friends to journey with. Meet regularly to pray together and discuss some aspect of following the Lord, encouraging each other to "do whatever He tells you." (Jn 2:5) There are many resources I would recommend to you for this time together, but here are a few high on my list:

- Pray the Holy Rosary together weekly with friends.
- Prayerfully read the Advent Reflections JPG has published and discuss them with a group of friends once a week focusing on what you think the Lord is calling you to through the reflections.
- Listen to the first episodes of Season 2 of *La Bonne Vie*, JPG's official podcast available on the website or podcasting platforms. The Advent episodes are focused on cultural commitments, discipleship, and Christ the Teacher. Talk about the episode with friends and share what Christ might be calling you to.

I pray God blesses all of us with an abundance of His grace this Holy Advent Season.
