DEAN OF STUDENT FORMATION

As you may have seen on this year's new *Totus Tuus* shirts, our formation theme for this school year is the Holy Spirit, Who leads us to the Truth (c.f. John 16:13). At the Last Supper, Jesus promised His disciples that the Holy Spirit would remain with them, would "teach [them] everything," and would recall to their memory all that He taught them (John 14:17, 26). St. Paul says that to be Christian means to "live by the Spirit" (Galatians 5:16),



but what does this look like? When we live by the Spirit, we make use of His gifts and can see His fruits in our lives.

The seven gifts of the Spirit enumerated in Isaiah 11:1-2— wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, fear of the Lord, and piety—are given to every Christian at Baptism, but they are fully "activated" or developed in us through the Sacrament of Confirmation. Each of us has the

same access to these gifts through the sacraments, but we must dispose ourselves to make use of them.

The nine fruits of the Spirit listed in Galatians 5:22-23— love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control— are evidence that we are allowing the Holy Spirit to work in and through us to make us more like Christ. Like the Beatitudes, we can use the fruits of the Spirit as a sort of examen, a way to consider how we are responding to God's grace and how we may be missing the mark in our walk with Him.

On the first day of school, we invited our Upper School students to prayerfully reflect on which fruit(s) of the Spirit they can see in their lives and which one(s) they want to pray for the grace to cultivate this year. Perhaps this would be a great place to start a family dialogue: which fruits of the Spirit do we experience often as a family? Do we habitually practice kindness to one another? Then, which fruits do we desire to see in our family life? Perhaps we can pray for the grace to be more patient with one another or more committed to nurturing a peaceful environment in our home.

In a 1998 address to Ecclesial Movements and New Communities, our patron Pope John Paul the Great said this of the Holy Spirit:

The Holy Spirit, already at work in the creation of the world and in the Old Covenant, reveals himself in the Incarnation and the Paschal Mystery of the Son of God, and in a way "bursts out" at Pentecost to extend the mission of Christ the Lord in time and space. The Spirit thus makes the Church a stream of new life that flows through the history of mankind. ... Whenever the Spirit intervenes, He leaves people astonished. He brings about events of amazing newness; He radically changes persons and history.

Let us dive into this year's theme together, ready to experience a new life in the Spirit, ready to be astonished by Him!
