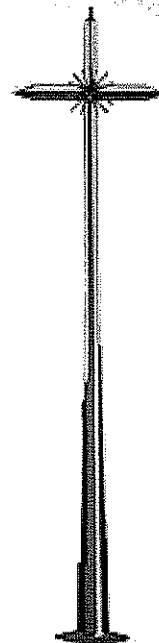

Out of Parish:

- We have much to be thankful for as Americans. But many of the values and liberties that have made our way of life so blessed are now being threatened. That's why it is imperative that each of us does our part to protect those values. The **Political Tax Credit** allows most taxpayers to give up to \$50*-and then receive every penny back when they file their 2014 Oregon tax return. **The deadline is December 31.** Remember, this is money you absolutely cannot keep. If it does not go to a qualified political organization like the Oregon Family Council PAC or Oregon Right to Life, you must pay it to the state in taxes. **Please note, due to a recent change in Oregon law, individuals with adjusted gross income over \$100,000 or joint filers with combined income exceeding \$200,000 no longer qualify for the Political Tax Credit.*
- **Feast of the Holy Innocents:** Rosary and Mass for the Little Saints will be on **Monday, December 29, at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic Church, 3145 SW 192nd Avenue, Aloha** beginning at **6:30 pm.** A reception will follow. This bilingual Mass remembers all deceased children, especially those who have died before birth or baptism, and for victims of abortion. Mass will be celebrated by Bishop Ken Steiner.

Baptism Guidelines

Do you want to have your child baptized at St. Francis Parish? There are several things to keep in mind when planning for the baptism.

- ◇ You **MUST** let the parish know at least three months before the day you want the child baptized. If you are pregnant, let us know three months before the scheduled birth date.
- ◇ The child **MUST** be less than 8 years of age, otherwise the program of RCIC (Rite of Christian Initiation for Children) applies. Call the parish office for details.
- ◇ You **MUST** be a registered member of St. Francis Parish.
- ◇ Both parents must attend with the prospective godparents if they are local, two training classes to understand your roles as parents and godparents in the raising of your child; and to also practice the rite of baptism.
- ◇ You **MUST** schedule a one-on-one visit with the pastor so he can get to know you a little better.
