The IRS informed the Archdiocese of Portland that, in an effort to assist individuals potentially affected by tax fraud, it is attempting to issue an Identity Protection PIN (IP PIN) number to every individual who had a criminal background check processed through the former background check vendor for the Archdiocese of Portland in Oregon and the Archdiocese of Seattle, regardless of when, or for which parish, school or other organization. The IP PIN has been or will be sent by the IRS via US Mail by early January 2015. **The IP PIN must be included on your 2014 tax return.** The IRS will not process returns that do not include this IP PIN in an effort to protect people from having a fraudulent return filed in their name for the 2014 tax year.

If you have questions, please contact the IRS Identity Protection Special Unit at 1-800-908-4490 or visit a Taxpayer Assistance Center. **Please do not contact the Archdiocese.** The Archdiocese has no information on the issuance of IP PINs.

## **Baptism Guidelines**

Do you want to have your child baptized at St. Francis Parish? There are several things to keep in mind when planning for the baptism.

- You MUST let the parish know at least three months before the day you want the child baptized. If you are pregnant, let us know three months before the scheduled birth date.
- The child MUST be less than 8 years of age, otherwise the program of RCIC (Rite of Christian Initiation for Children) applies. Call the parish office for details.
- ♦ You MUST be a registered member of St. Francis Parish.
- Both parents must attend with the prospective godparents if they are local, two training classes to understand your roles as parents and godparents in the raising of your child; and to also practice the rite of baptism.
- ♦ You MUST schedule a one-on-one visit with the pastor so he can get to know you a little better.
