HOPE SHELTER: The Hope Shelter recently wrapped up its third season. The shelter was open 22 nights, for a total of 408 "bed stays". We served 67 different guests, about 20 more than last year. The average guest count per night has increased each year: Year 1= 8 guests per night, Year 2=15 guests per night and Year 3= 19 guests per night.

Thank you very much to Rob Watson and all the shelter volunteers who made this past winter so successful! Our volunteer team logged 1540 volunteer hours over the shelter season, and served in a variety of roles, from bus driver, to overnight monitors, to Monday morning breakfast and laundry. This fall, please look for more information in the bulletin and website about the many ways to get involved in this rewarding ministry.


