From the Pastor

I would like to thank you for your positive response to the second collection taken up to augment the School's Tuition Assistance Fund. We collected \$6,542.16. I also would like to thank you for your generous response to our first Benefit Brunch as fund-raising for our School Endowment Fund (CEEF). We received a total pledge of \$92,950. Both the Tuition Assistance Fund and the CEEF (Catholic Education Endowment Fund) exist to provide financial assistance to students at St. Francis School. While the origin of the proverb "It takes a village to raise a child" is unclear, the concept is not alien to our Christian heritage. It really does take the whole community to be a 'Church'. It is the responsibility of all to build up the Body of Christ. Let me end with a quote from Pope Francis on the value of Catholic Education. He writes in his Encyclical Letter, The Joy of the Gospel: "The process of secularization tends to reduce the faith and the Church to the sphere of the private and personal. Furthermore, by completely rejecting the transcendent, it has produced a growing deterioration of ethics, a weakening of the sense of personal and collective sin, and a steady increase in relativism. These have led to a general sense of disorientation, especially in the periods of adolescence and young adulthood which are so vulnerable to change. ... We are living in an information-driven society which bombards us indiscriminately with data—all treated as being of equal importance—and which leads to remarkable superficiality in the area of moral discernment. In response, we need to provide an education which teaches critical thinking and encourages the development of mature moral values (64)." Blessingp, Fr. Ysrael




