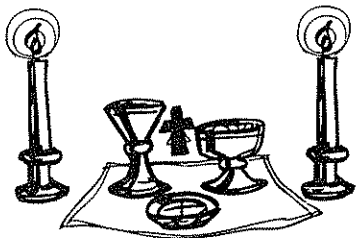

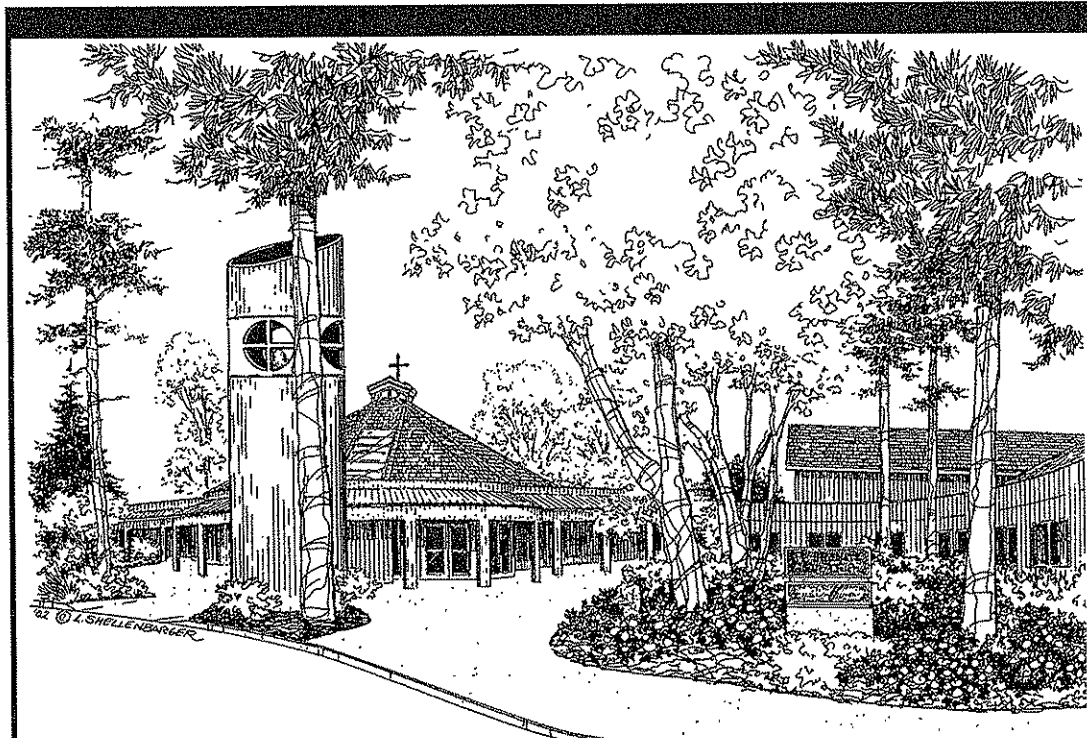

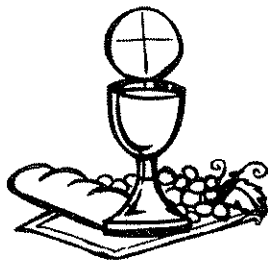

From the desk of Father James

While we have just completed the 8th week of Ordinary Time, the second week of Ordinary Time since the conclusion of the Easter Season with Pentecost, we still do not see the green vestments this Sunday. Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, traditionally known as the feast of Corpus Christi. Again, this is one of those feasts that is transferred here in the United States from the second Thursday after Pentecost to the following Sunday.

I remember back in the summer of 2010 when I spent eight weeks in Mexico studying the Spanish language and culture. It was truly an amazing experience, because I got to see so many different customs and traditions that are a part of my culture. My father is originally from Mexico.

One of the things that I still remember the most, were the days leading up to Corpus Christi. In Mexico, it was still celebrated on Thursday, and for 9 days leading up to the solemnity, they had special prayers (a novena) and what really caught my attention is that they set off fireworks every morning, at 6 AM. That was my alarm clock for the 9 days leading up to the feast. There was a huge celebration on the Thursday afternoon of the Feast. All the streets in the neighborhood where I lived were closed and they had a huge procession with the Blessed Sacrament in the street around the local parish. It lasted all afternoon and as the Eucharist was processed through the streets, the procession would stop at all of the various home altars set up outside and give people along the way time to adore our Blessed Lord in the Sacrament.

While we may not have the ability to do that here at St. Francis, this day certainly reminds us of the importance that the Eucharist has in our lives. This solemnity is about the Eucharist, the unity that we share with one another, and with our Triune God. This is truly a gift that our loving God has sent down from heaven for us.

Let us take a moment this weekend to reflect on the gift that this Sacrament gives to each one of us and the gift of life and nourishment that we receive from the Body and Blood of Christ. Let us also give thanks to our God for this amazing gift that He has bestowed upon us and the unity that it brings to each one of us who are members of the Body of Christ.

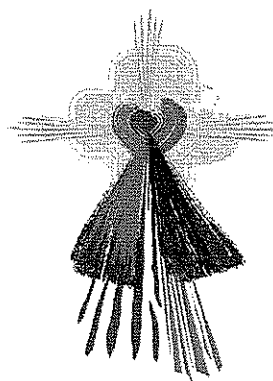
