


Being productive, not provocative

Words can make/mold or mar a relationship. We become what we speak. The old adage of, "Tell me your friend and I will tell you who you are" could easily be altered as, "Speak few words to me and I will tell you who you are". Such a powerful tool we have in our hands, to bring good news and glad tidings to others.

Unfortunately, either we shun our words when we need to speak, but flatter many words when and where they are not needed at all, or we recourse to some words to provoke others and as a result ruin the warmth in our relationship. But the WORD that is given to us is powerful and allowing it to grow in us will produce plentiful harvest. Hence, all our human words are to be coated into the Divine Word.


We now look forward to making arrangements for the First Communicants to receive their First Holy Communion throughout July and August.


