- 1] Bonnie White opened the meeting with a prayer.
- 2] Treasurer Report: Toni Hellums gave the following report of activity in the checking account:

Beginning Balance: \$2552.69; Income was - \$39 from prayer candles. Expenses were: \$300.60 for 6 cases of prayer candles. Closing Balance is \$2291.09.

- 4] Held a discussion on the May 20 Co-Parish Picnic at St. Judes at 11:30am. Dawna Schlickelman has talked to Dana Tucker, St. Jude Altar Society president about the tentative plans. The Knights from both parishes will be in charge of the meat and plan to grill. Keeping with a picnic theme, both Altar Societies will furnish the side dishes. We discussed at our meeting that to keep things organized and simple that each of the parish groups be responsible for one or two item categories, and St. George is volunteering to do a variety of potato salads along with another category. Dana also mentioned getting a large cake from Costco commemorating the first ever event. Their Altar Society will meet this next Thursday, April 26. She will call me before their meeting to see what we have come up with and bring that up at their meeting.
- 5] We have been asked by Caitlin to serve at the lunch and the reception for the Deanery 8 Confirmation being held at St. George on Sunday, April 22. There will be a practice for all the kids, sponsors, and teachers at 11:30am in the church and it is expected they will come over to the Meeting Hall to eat lunch around 12:15pm.
