Baptisms

Would you like to have your child Baptized? Arrangements are required at least three weeks in advance to schedule Baptisms.

Baptism Godparents

One must be at least 14 years old, registered as an adult and be confirmed in the Catholic Church. If you are married, your marriage must be recognized by the Church. This is especially important if you wish to be a Godparent for Baptism. It takes six months of attending Mass to be eligible for this privilege.

Penance/Reconciliation

Would you like to clean your heart and soul and begin a new journey with Christ? We invite you to participate in the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation at the times specified in the front of this bulletin.

Holy Eucharist

We invite you to participate in the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist daily at the times specified on the front of this bulletin. If you have not had the opportunity to make your Holy Eucharist, please contact Ms. Veronica Collingwood at the Parish Office or email her to make arrangements. We welcome second graders and also children who have not received the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist.

Fourth Sunday of Advent

"Mary said to the angel: 'How can this be, since I do not know man?' The angel answered her: 'The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the most high will overshadow you, hence the holy offspring to be born will be called the Son of God... Mary said, 'I am the maidservant of the Lord. Let it be done unto me as you say.' With that the angel left her... The word became flesh and he made his dwelling among us."

First Reading: 2 Samuel 7:1-5, 8-12, 14, 16

King David plans to build a temple to honor God. But God tells Nathan the Prophet that instead he will give David rest from his enemies, and ensure that both his house and community will be protected forever.

Second Reading: Romans 16:25-27

In this letter of Paul to the Romans, he explains that the gospel reveals the mystery that had been hidden for many ages. Now it has been made known to all, so that they may believe, obey, and give glory through Jesus Christ forever.

Gospel: Luke 1:26-38

The Virgin Mary is approached by the angel Gabriel, who tells her that she has been chosen to bear the Son of God. Mary is first afraid, yet shows her unquestioning faith when she simply says, "Let it be done to me as you say."

"Never feel ashamed to pray in difficult times"

"My Dear Brothers and Sisters:

Pope Francis said the prayer of supplication is "very human". He said at some point in everyone's life the illusion of self-sufficiency crumbles. "The human being is an invocation, that at times becomes a cry, often withheld." We all experience loneliness or sadness, he said. The Bible does not shy away from showing humanity at its weakest, when sickness, injustice, or betrayal seem to win out. "At times it seems that everything collapses, that the life lived so far has been in vain. In these seemingly hopeless situations, there is only one way out: the cry, the prayer 'Lord, help me!'. Prayer can open up a sliver of light in the densest darkness."

Pope Francis urged Christians not to feel ashamed when we feel the need to pray in our moments of darkness, though we should also learn to pray in times of happiness as well. "We must not suffocate the supplication that rises up in us spontaneously," he said. "Prayer of petition goes in step with acceptance of our limit and our nature as creatures." Prayer, added the Pope, presents itself to everyone as a cry from the depths, even if we seek to suppress it.

Finally, Pope Francis assured everyone that God will respond, as the Bible makes abundantly clear. "Even our stammering questions, even those that remain in the depths of our heart. The Father hears them and wishes to give us the Holy Spirit, which inspires every prayer and transforms everything." Our task, he concluded, is to wait patiently for God's response to our prayer of supplication."

"Diocese, through consecration, forever tethered to Mary"

"My Dear Brothers and Sisters:

Mary always desires to bring us to her Son. St. Juan Diego used his tilma, his cloak, and gathered up the roses which miraculously appeared on the Hill of Tepeyac. They were used as proof of Mary's visit to us. When he released the roses in front of the Bishop, Mary's image appeared on the cloak. It is the only image of Mary that she left of herself in our world, a "selfie" of herself if you will. Normally, the images of Mary we have from her apparitions are reports of what the visionaries saw, but this image was left by her. It has miraculously been preserved through all these years. Just as St. Juan Diego gathered the roses in his cloak, which was usually used for gathering vegetation from gardens or transporting other objects, so Mary is now gathering all of us in her cloak, to bring us closer to heart of her Son.

We take our first steps with increased prayer, prayer to our Blessed Mother, having a special relationship with her, for she has chosen us for this Consecration. She has sought us out as her special project so to speak and she wants to accomplish great things here in our diocese for Her Son, because she is our loving Mother who never turns away from us.

My brothers and sisters, thank you for your faithfulness to God and our Mother Mary, thank you for your faithfulness to our Church, and also, for your love and support of me as I work with whatever energy and grace God gives me to guide our local Church to a brighter future in God, to be the shepherd you deserve; I am so grateful to you. Enhanced Incentive for Charitable Giving

The CARES Act enacted by Congress and the President in March of this year is providing individuals an opportunity to increase their charitable giving for the 2020 tax year by increasing the tax deductions for charitable donations. We encourage you to consider our parish for your charitable donations this year, and avail of this incentive. Our parish has been a source of much needed support for our fellow parishioners who have been adversely affected by the pandemic, and we've utilized our resources to provide assistance. Your generosity will be greatly appreciated.

We provide below links to both the Diocese of Metuchen and IRS websites which contain much detail, but the key points are as follows:

- Individual donor benefits: All taxpayers (both those who itemize and those who use standard deduction) can deduct up to \$300 of total charitable contributions in 2020. Prior to the CARES Act, those who use, standard deduction could not deduct any charitable giving.
- Additional benefits for those who itemize their taxes:
 The law lifts the existing cap on annual contributions for those who itemize their taxes, significantly raising it from 60% of adjusted gross income to 100% of adjusted gross income.
- Incentives for corporations: The CARES Act raises the annual limit of charitable giving that corporations can deduct from 10% of taxable income to 25% of taxable income.


