Baptisms

Would you like to have your child Baptized? Arrangements are required at least three weeks in advance to schedule Baptisms.

Baptism Godparents

One must be at least 14 years old, registered as an adult and be confirmed in the Catholic Church. If you are married, your marriage must be recognized by the Church. This is especially important if you wish to be a Godparent for Baptism. It takes six months of attending Mass to be eligible for this privilege.

Penance/Reconciliation

Would you like to clean your heart and soul and begin a new journey with Christ? We invite you to participate in the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation at the times specified in the front of this bulletin.

Holy Eucharist

We invite you to participate in the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist daily at the times specified on the front of this bulletin. If you have not had the opportunity to make your Holy Eucharist, please contact Ms. Veronica Collingwood at the Parish Office or email her to make arrangements. Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Then they came to Capernaum, and on the Sabbath Jesus entered the synagogue and taught. The people were astonished at his teaching, for he taught as one having authority and not as the scribes... All were amazed and asked one another: 'What is this? A new teaching with authority. He commands even the unclean spirits and they obey him.' His fame spread everywhere throughout the whole region of Galilee."

First Reading: Deuteronomy 18:15-20

Moses explains to the people that a prophet will come from among them, and that they should listen to this prophet's words, for God has told him of this prophet. God also tells Moses that anyone who pretends to speak in his words, or speaks in the name of other gods shall die.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 7:32-35

Paul tells the Corinthians how an unmarried man or woman is able to devote themselves fully to God without concern for the needs of a spouse. Paul explains that God wants to help them promote good and devote themselves more fully to God.

Gospel: Mark 1:21-28

As Jesus was teaching, a man with an unclean spirit came to the synagogue and asked if Jesus had come to destroy them. Jesus ordered the spirit out of the man, who shrieked violently as the spirit departed. The people were amazed at the authority he had over the spirit.

"Christian unity achieved only through God's grace"

"My Dear Brothers and Sisters:

As Christians around the world observe the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, Pope Francis reflects on Jesus' invitation to overcome discord and sow reconciliation. Speaking in the catechesis portion of his weekly General Audience, the Pope reminded everyone that Jesus did not command His disciples to be united, but rather prayed that they might be. This, said the Pope, "means that we are not able to achieve unity with our own strength. Unity is above all a gift, a grace to be requested through prayer."

"To pray means to fight for unity," said the Pope. This means fighting against the discord and division which the devil seeks to sow by magnifying the defects and mistakes of others in our eyes. God, however, offers another path. "He takes us as we are, different, sinners, and nudges us towards unity." So, Pope Francis invited everyone to sow unity in our homes and workplaces with the tools God has given us: "prayer and love."

Finally, Pope Francis reflected on the theme of this year's Week of Prayer for Christian Unity: "Abide in my love and you shall bear much fruit." "The root of communion and love is Christ who makes us overcome our prejudices to see in others a brother or sister to be loved always," he said. By seeking unity, we find that Christians of other confessions are gifts from God. "Let us begin to pray for them and, when possible, with them," concluded Pope Francis. "We will thus learn to love and appreciate them."

"You're never too old to reach out to young"

"My Dear Brothers and Sisters:

When writing I generally try to reach as broad an audience as possible, but, as we begin this new year, I'd like to address myself to those who feel they are growing old. "Aren't we all growing old?" you might wonder. Well, yes and no! Although Pope Francis often expresses his esteem and appreciation for the elderly, he also speaks of "growing old" as something to avoid at all costs. He refers to a certain kind of aging: "growing old out of sorrow, resentment or fear, doubt or failure," of being "encased in the past," and letting one's horizons shrink.

In his book on aging, "Sharing the Wisdom of Time," the pope laments older people who have become cynical. "They become unwilling to share their experience," he writes. "They look down on young people. They are always complaining. They cannot share wisdom. They can only look back fruitlessly on earlier times." At the same time, Pope Francis affirms the Biblical admonition to "to accept the authority of those who are older" (1 Pet 5:5). "The Bible never ceases to insist that profound respect be shown to the elderly, since they have a wealth of experience," he writes. "In the silence of their heart, they have a store of experiences that can teach us not to make mistakes or be taken in by false promises." "Jesus tells us that the wise are able to bring forth from their store things both new and old (cf. Mt 13:52)," Francis continues. Herein lies the key to aging without growing old — to remain flexible, to accumulate wisdom and to know how to bring forth from one's store both old and new.

We tend to choose our friends from those like us The older we get, therefore, the more twenty-somethings seem foreign to us, and we to them, unless we make concerted attempts to bridge the gap." Twenty-somethings are showing us just how foreign we are to them.

In this new year, let's shake off whatever is weighing us down and limiting our horizons so that we can reach out with open arms and hearts to welcome the younger generations into the Church and to show them how much God loves them and is waiting for them."




