One must be at least 14 years old, registered as an adult and be confirmed in the Catholic Church. If you are married, your marriage must be recognized by the Church. This is especially important if you wish to be a Godparent for Baptism. It takes six months of attending Mass to be eligible for this privilege.

Penance/Reconciliation

Would you like to clean your heart and soul and begin a new journey with Christ? We invite you to participate in the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation at the times specified in the front of this bulletin.

Holy Eucharist

We invite you to participate in the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist daily at the times specified on the front of this bulletin. Fourth Sunday Of Lent

"God who is rich in mercy because of his great love for us, even when we were dead in our transgressions, brought us to life with Christ – by grace you have been saved... For by grace you have been saved through faith and this is not from you, it is the gift of God; it is not from works, so no one can boast. For we are his handiwork created in Christ Jesus for the good works that God has prepared in advance, that we should live in them."

First Reading: 2 Chronicles 36:14-16, 19-23

The people of Judah practiced many abominations, even polluting God's temple in Jerusalem. They mocked the messengers he sent among them, until he grew so angry he delivered them to the King of the Chaldeans. Those who weren't killed were exiled and became servants for seventy years. Cyrus, King of Persia, was ordered to build a temple to God in Jerusalem, and he freed the servants as God had inspired him to do.

Second Reading: Ephesians 2:4-10

Paul declares that God brought us to life in Jesus, though we had been dead from our sins. He reminds us that it was not a reward for our good service so no one should take credit. Instead, we must remember that it was not our doing, but a sign of God's mercy and love for us.

Gospel: John 3:14-21

God so loved the world, he sent us his only Son so that all who believed would have eternal life in him. The light came into the world, but those who were wicked avoided it, for fear that their evil deeds would be exposed. But those who believed were unafraid of the light, where it would be clear that their deeds were done in God.

Witness to My Faith Journey

I have learned to experience God in endless ways. He is the one who has subtly throughout my life created key moments in my journey with Christ. While He has not always been a priority, I always felt His presence. He has not given up on me. Jesus persisted by placing in my path people of faith and opportunities to imitate Christ through love, prayer and giving. I learned that God has given me graces, charisms, and does not want me to be a conformist: "Do not be conformed to this world but be transformed by the renewal of your mind." Romans 12:2. He wants me to ponder as to what is my purpose on earth, and to follow Jesus, as well as prioritize Him in my daily life.

This Lenten journey has been an opportunity for me to reconnect and give more of myself to Jesus Christ through thoughtful and inward focused prayer and journaling. My passion to reconnect with Jesus Christ has helped me to increase my prayer time. I start my day in silent prayer and then move into reflection of the daily Gospel. In my time of prayer, I always ask the Holy Spirit to help deepen my spiritual connection with Christ. This has helped me to see how the Holy Spirit truly does work in our lives.

I have always had a deep devotion to the Rosary. It helps me to reflect on the mysteries of our Lord and His life. This love of the Rosary was instilled in me by my grandmother who practiced her faith with a profound love for our Blessed Virgin Mary. I cherish these memories greatly!

I also have a practice of finding time to pause throughout the day to speak with Christ. When I do this, I give thanks for the many blessings of the day and ask Jesus to provide for those who are in need. I use both formal prayer, informal ways, as well as reciting an Our Father in the moment.

Right now, my prayer time in the evening concludes with the consecration of St. Joseph. I am using the book the parish provided for reflection and journaling as well as sharing in a discussion with the family on what I have contemplated throughout the day.

My prayer time has slowly been increasing. This time of prayer is important to me because I wholeheartedly desire to know Him more and understand what it means to follow Him, so that I may deepen my relationship with Jesus Christ during this Lenten season and beyond. I pray that by sharing my own experience, it may inspire or encourage you to take one small step in your own prayer life.

"Prayer opens us to the Trinity"

"My Dear Brothers and Sisters:

"It is Jesus who opened up Heaven to us and projected us into a relationship with God," Pope Francis said at Wednesday's General Audience. "Jesus has revealed to us the identity, this identity of God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit." It is only through Jesus that we have the "courage" to believe in a God that loves humanity, the Pope said. We see the love of God in the parables of the merciful father and of the shepherd who goes in search of the lost sheep. But, Pope Francis said, "We would not have been able to conceive or even comprehend such stories if we had not met Jesus."

"What kind of God is prepared to die for people? What kind of God loves always and patiently, without demanding to be loved in return? What God accepts the tremendous lack of gratitude of a son who asks for his inheritance in advance and leaves home, squandering everything?"

It is through His life, and His willingness to die for us, that Jesus shows us "the extent to which God is our Father... the paternity that is closeness, compassion, and tenderness." We cannot comprehend the mutual love of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit in the Trinity, Pope Francis said, and without Jesus, we would not have been able to begin to understand "that this divine love would expand, landing on our human shore."

Quoting the <u>Catechism</u>, Pope Francis explained, "The sacred humanity of Jesus is therefore the way by which the Holy Spirit teaches us to pray to God our Father." This, he said in conclusion, "is the grace of our faith. We truly could not have hoped for a higher vocation: the humanity of Jesus is made available to us the very life of the Trinity."



Prayer Intention for March 2021 Sacrament of Reconciliation

Let us pray that we may experience the sacrament of reconciliation with renewed depth, to taste the infinite mercy of God.

"Lent is time to renew encounter with Lord, be like Christ"

"My Dear Brothers and Sisters:

Just a few days ago, we entered into the season of Lent—a time which calls us to sanctify our lives and unite ourselves more deeply with Christ through prayer, fasting and almsgiving. But it is also a season which leaves us ripe for renewal; a time in which we renew our encounter with Christ and give witness to His word, as well as mindfully participate in the sacraments, especially the Eucharist, so that we may conform our lives to be more like His.

In a time when we are physically distant from one another, when we have faced individual sufferings and sufferings as a universal Church, when we have lost more than 400,000 of our American brothers and sisters to the coronavirus — it seems only right that we would long to be united in the Eucharist, by which we are united to Christ, the whole Church, and all the faithful departed. The Eucharist is "a sacrament of love, a sign of unity, a bond of charity, a Paschal banquet 'in which Christ is consumed, the mind is filled with grace, and a pledge of future glory is given to us." (Catechism of the Catholic Church 1323)

My brothers and sisters, our path to the cross is certainly winding. It seems especially so when we are faced with challenges, as we all have been throughout this pandemic, and when we, as a Church, were called to acknowledge and reconcile the past failings of the Church's leaders with the release of the Holy See's "McCarrick Report." This report, although much anticipated, was nonetheless gut-wrenching, disappointing and disgusting when released, a reminder to us of how much damage has been done to the Body of Christ, especially to those abused and taken advantage of through a series of failures that we must be ever vigilant to never allow to happen again. As I did last year and will continue to do, as part of my own commitment to this necessary healing of past abuse in the Body of Christ, I will continue to make known to you the needed steps that we take to be transparent and forthright in the protocols and policies that help ensure integrity on every level of our diocesan life."


