Baptisms

Would you like to have your child Baptized? Arrangements are required at least three weeks in advance to schedule Baptisms.

Baptism Godparents

One must be at least 14 years old, registered as an adult and be confirmed in the Catholic Church. If you are married, your marriage must be recognized by the Church. This is especially important if you wish to be a Godparent for Baptism. It takes six months of attending Mass to be eligible for this privilege.

Penance/Reconciliation

Would you like to clean your heart and soul and begin a new journey with Christ? We invite you to participate in the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation at the times specified in the front of this bulletin.

Holy Eucharist

We invite you to participate in the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist daily at the times specified on the front of this bulletin. If you have not had the opportunity to make your Holy Eucharist, please contact Ms. Veronica Collingwood at the Parish Office or email her to make arrangements. We welcome second graders and also children who have not received the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist.

Ascension of the Lord

"Beloved, if God so loved us, we also must love one another. No one has ever seen God. Yet, if we love one another God remains in us, and His love is brought to perfection in us. This is how we know that we remain in him and he in us, that he has given us of his Spirit."

First Reading: Acts of the Apostles 1:1-11

"Contemplation"

Most Reverend James F. Checchio Bishop of Metuchen



"Contemplative prayer, a guide along path of love"

"My Dear Brothers and Sisters:

Added Pope Francis, the contemplative aspect of our nature requires us to enter into faith and love before it can become prayer. "Being contemplatives does not depend on the eyes, but on the heart," he noted. "And here prayer enters into play as an act of faith and love, as the 'breath' of our relationship with God." The Pope said prayer purifies our heart and sharpens our gaze, "allowing it to grasp reality from another point of view." Citing the Holy Curé of Ars, he said "contemplation is a gaze of faith, fixed on Jesus." "Everything comes from this: from a heart that feels that it is looked on with love. Then reality is contemplated with different eyes."

Pope Francis then warned against falling into the ancient temptation of thinking contemplation is opposed to action. He said some spiritual masters of the past advocated this dualistic understanding of prayer. "In reality, in Jesus Christ and the Gospel, there is no opposition between contemplation and action," said the Pope. He said the only great call in the Gospel is to follow Jesus along the path of love. "This is the pinnacle and center of everything. In this sense, charity and contemplation are synonymous; they say the same thing."

Pope Francis concluded his catechesis recalling a teaching from St. John of the Cross, one of the Church's greatest mystics and masters of contemplative prayer. "A small act of pure love is more useful to the Church than all the other works combined," said the Pope. "What is born of prayer and not from the presumption of our ego, what is purified by humility, even if it is a hidden and silent act of love, is the greatest miracle that a Christian can perform."

"Bishop encourages seniors to continue as keepers of the faith"

"My Dear Brothers and Sisters:

Standing beneath a stained glass window depicting the visitation of the angel Gabriel to the Blessed Virgin Mary, Bishop James F. Checchio told the seniors seated before him, "Like Mary, you are deeply aware of the presence of God in your lives. You, too, model discipleship in our day."

In his homily, Bishop Checchio said Mary was the ideal disciple, and her freely-given "yes" to carry the Son of God in her womb "was the jubilant door through which God entered the world becoming man." "She prepared herself by prayer, opened herself to God and his will... she was the first missionary by sharing the Good News with her cousin, Elizabeth," he added. Bishop Checchio charged the seniors to continue their important role as keepers of the faith, saying: "Speak with and to God. Be a missionary. Bring the presence of Christ into the world by what you say and do."

"It can be an opportunity to be reminded that our elderly brothers and sisters have lived a life of 'fiat' and, in their golden years, are profound witnesses of saying 'yes' to God over and over again," she wrote. "As we begin this year of the family, let us express our profound gratitude for the many ways in which faithful and generous older Catholics have built — and continue to build — the Church."

"You, too, model discipleship in our day. Children need that example and you clearly provide it for them," he said. "Seminarians reference their grandparents' faith for reawakening their faith or for being a priest. Know it provides you a strong, solid foundation in their lives. Your examples will come back to them. Never doubt it."

"The seniors have been impacted significantly during the pandemic," Sister Anna said. "Our grandparents are needed, they are special, and they are our example of Mary's fiat."
