Letter of St. Paul to the Hebrews

Left: In the tender compassion of our God the dawn from on high shall break upon us, to shine on those who dwell in darkness and the shadow of death, and to guide our feet into the way of peace.

Left: You made the cross the tree of life,

Right: give its fruit to those reborn in baptism.

ALL: *Lord, Hear our prayer*

Intercessions

Left: On the cross you forgave the repentant thief,

Right: forgive us our sins.

ALL: *Lord, Hear our prayer*

Intercessions

Left: Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done on earth, as it is in heaven.

Right: Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Concluding Prayer

Leader: O God, who anointed your Only Begotten Son with the Holy Spirit and made him Christ and Lord, graciously grant that, being made sharers in his consecration, we may bear witness to your Redemption in the world. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever. Amen.
