Corpus Christi Procession:

Mass to conclude the 33-day Novena to Our Lady, Undoer of Knots:

Our parish has been in the midst of a 33-day Novena praying for those struggling with addiction and the whole addiction problem in our community. We will conclude the Novena on Saturday, June 24, with a morning Mass at 8:30 a.m. As it is the Saturday after the Feast of the Sacred Heart, it is normally celebrated as the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary (the title under which our sisters' religious order is dedicated) but as it falls on June 24, it is the Solemnity of the Nativity of John the Baptist this year. A very holy day indeed! Join us for Holy Mass that morning.
