

## **PASTOR'S COLUMN**

Prepare to Consecrate Yourself – After a lively discussion at Parish Council the other night about evangelization and about the need to ask Our Blessed Mother to intercede for us in this area and to consecrate ourselves to Jesus through Mary, I have decided to invite the whole parish to join in consecrating ourselves to Jesus through Mary. There are so many blessings the Lord waits to give us until we go through Mary (just as he stood by at Cana when the wine ran dry and waited for Our Lady to come and intercede with him before he worked his miracles in abundance [see John 2:1-11]).

There is a tradition coming down through St. Louis deMontfort of making a 33-day preparation before consecrating oneself to Jesus through Mary. We have decided to use a specific means, the book "33 Days to Morning Glory" by Fr. Michael Gaitley. We have purchased 150 of these books for any parishioner who wants to make the consecration together with us on October 14. Why October 14? The final day of preparation will then be on October 13, 2017 – the 100th anniversary of the final apparition of Our Lady of Fatima. Our evangelization coordinator, Chris Hiles, had already secured a permit to hold a Rosary Rally at the Court House on Saturday, Oct. 14 at noon to mark the 100th anniversary. Normally we have a Rosary Procession after Mass on the First Sunday of October but this year we will be processing on Saturday, October 14 to the Court House for a Rosary Rally. What better way to begin than for all who would like to, to meet at the Church, make our consecration and then process to the Court House to give public witness to our love for our Lord Jesus Christ and our Blessed Mother.

We hope to have the books available this weekend, but if they aren't in, they will certainly be in by next weekend and the first of the 33 days of preparation would be Monday, September 11 (a very fitting day to begin this with a sense of the urgency of our times!)

In the meantime, if you would like to delve in deeper with your family or gather a group, there are free resources through our FORMED subscription. If you're not yet registered, see elsewhere in this bulletin how to register, and then once logged into FORMED, go to the STUDY heading, click on FAITH FORMATION, and then scroll down until you see "33 Days to Morning Glory".

Also, I've asked Parish Council President, Eric Rinehart, to speak at the end of the Masses next weekend about his own personal experience of having consecrated himself to Jesus through Mary using this specific means.

If you have another 33-day consecration (Montfort fathers, etc.) by all means feel free to use that one for the preparation. If you do not plan to make the consecration on the 14th we would just ask that you not take a book this weekend or next, but after that the books will be available for those who plan to start there 33-day preparation at another time.

**Fr. David Young** – This weekend at the 11:30 a.m. Mass we welcome Fr. David Young. Fr. Young is recently retired from the Western Scioto County parishes and now lives at St. Sylvester, Zaleski and helps us with the pastoral work there.

**High School Youth** – A reminder to our high school youth that we have a cook-out kick-off on the parish grounds this Thursday at 7:00 p.m. This year's Thursdays will be a rotation of Dead Theologian's Society (led by Dr. Greg Thompson and myself – come find out about our return to the "catacombs"); Service nights – living more fully the "Presence to the Poor" of our parish's mission; Worship Nights – living more fully the "founded on Adoration" of our parish's mission; and Social and Game nights – living more fully the "Community" of our parish's mission.

We want our parishioners to be a presence to the poor, but your safety is our first concern as well.
