EDCHOICE SCHOLARSHIPS

Despite the Franklin County Ruling, All EdChoice Scholarships Remain Intact for the 2025-2026 School Year

A Franklin County judge has ruled in favor of plaintiffs claiming the EdChoice program is unconstitutional. **Despite this ruling, the EdChoice program remains in place**, available to all Ohio families, as the case proceeds through the appeals process. Attorneys defending the EdChoice program are very confident the constitutionality of the program will prevail at the Ohio Supreme Court. Therefore, we remain confident about the future of EdChoice Scholarship funding at this time.

ALTAR SERVER TRAINING

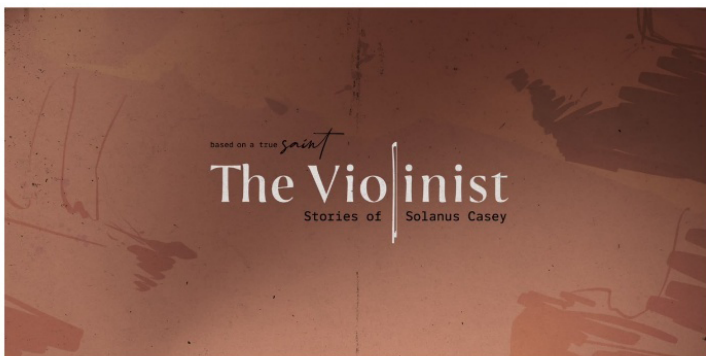
Saturday, August 16 at 3:00 p.m., hosted at St. Mary, Chillicothe
