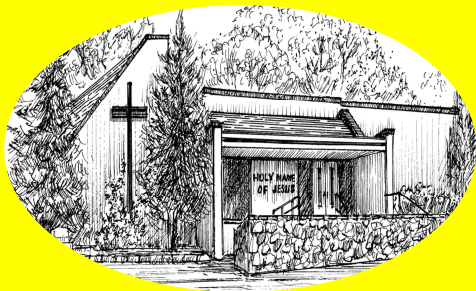

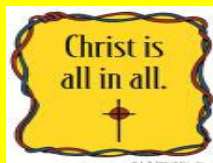
BULLETINS EMAILED DIRECTLY TO PARISHIONERS

PRAYER SHAWL MINISTRY

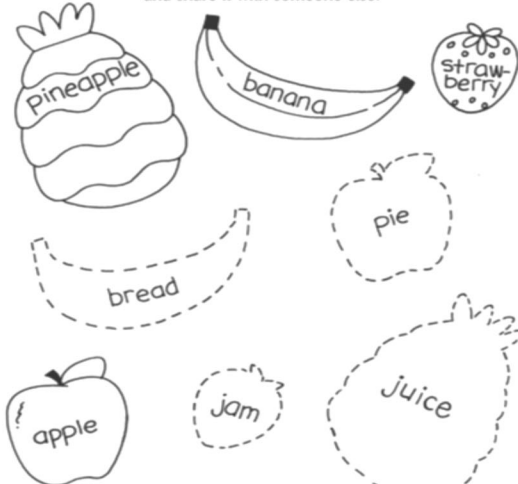
On Tuesday Mornings at 9:30am in the Church Parking Lot join the Ladies for a morning of knitting or crocheting.

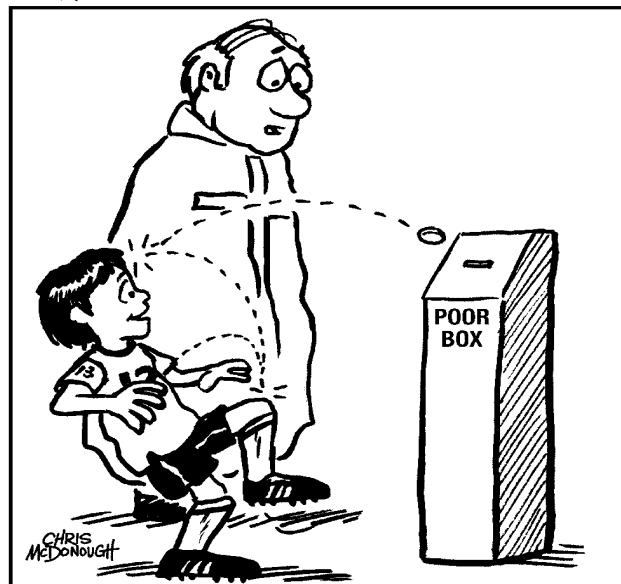

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SEEK THE LORD

So the prophet invites us (Isaiah 55:6). We can look for Jesus in many different places, one of them being our parish church. Our church teaches that Jesus is present in the word (scripture), in the bread and wine, in the person of the priest, and in the people who gather together. With an adult, reverently walk around your church and identify these places.

Jesus is present in the Word.

Where do the lector (reader) and the priest or deacon stand to proclaim the word?

Stand next to this place and look at it closely. How would you describe it?

Jesus is present in the Eucharist.

Where is the consecrated bread kept after the liturgy? This place is called the tabernacle. Stand where you can see it. How would you describe it?

Jesus is present in the person of the priest.

Where does the priest stand during the Mass? Do you know the names of your priests? Where is the altar? What does it look like? What is it made of?

Jesus is present in the people.

That includes you. Before you leave the church, sit in a pew. Think about how Jesus is present in you. What does that mean? You must bring Jesus to everyone you meet. Say a prayer asking God to show you how you can bring Jesus to others.



When Jesus is present, God is present. God can be found anywhere. On your walk or ride home, think of other places and things that show you the presence of God. When you arrive home, take some time to draw a picture of all the places and people who show you God's presence. Remember to draw yourself and your family.

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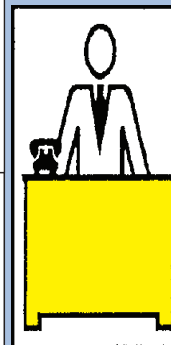
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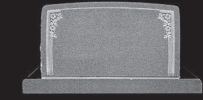
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
