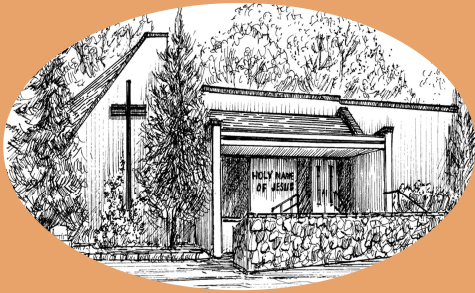

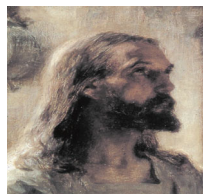

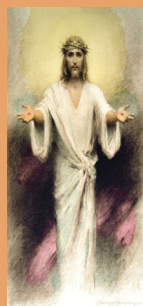

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

The Archdiocese of New York has recently announced that any vaccinated person may attend Mass without wearing a mask, Holy Name of Jesus asks the following:

If you are vaccinated and prefer not to wear a mask, please sit in the section of pews closest to the front door

If you are vaccinated and still prefer to wear a mask, please sit in one of the other three pew sections or in the gym.

For those not vaccinated, masks and social distancing will continue to be required

Cleaning and disinfecting of the Church will continue after every Mass.

You must continue to use the side door to enter the Church.

Ushers will continue to assist with seating, especially in the physically distance sections

The ionizing system will continue to be on during all Masses

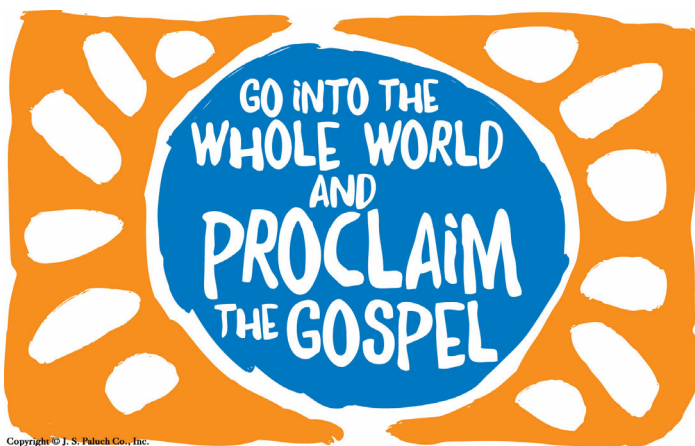

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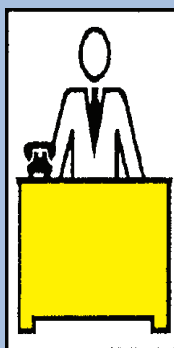
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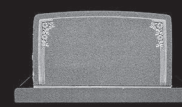
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
