

A Word from Servant of God Isaac Hecker, Founder of the Paulist Fathers

The Bicentennial Year theme for October is **Evangelization**

Pope Paul VI called evangelization "the essential mission of the Church." Although Hecker did not employ that particular terminology, we can readily recognize and apply to our own situation his consistent commitment to call Catholics to the fullness of their mission to evangelize their society – and, to that end, to enhance the quality of Church life, to build up the Catholic Church in the United States. Hecker understood that any successful mission to non-Catholic America presupposed an effective mission and ministry within the American Catholic community. Today, we are even more apt to appreciate the importance of vibrant personal spirituality and internal Church community life for the effectiveness of the Church's mission outward to our society.

"We cannot even preserve the faith among Catholics in any better way than by advancing it among our non-Catholic brethren. Indeed, simply to preserve the faith it is necessary to extend it. It is a state of chronic disease for me to live together and not endeavor to communicate their respective good fortune. A Catholic without a mission to his non-Catholic fellow-citizens in these times, and when only a small portion of the human race has the true religion, is only half a Catholic."
