

From the desk of Deacon Kelley

The Feast of Corpus Christi is a solemn act of faith in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Blessed Eucharist. Also known as the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, this feast honors Jesus Christ, really, truly, and substantially Present under the appearances of bread and wine. This Presence happens through the change which the Church calls transubstantiation ("change of substance"), when at the consecration of the Mass, the priest says the words which Christ Himself pronounced over bread and wine, "This is My Body," "This is the chalice of My Blood," "Do this in remembrance of Me."

This is the very essence of our Catholic faith. But as national polls show – we have work to do within our own Church. Many Catholics today do not believe in the Real Presence of our Lord in the Eucharist. This is significant because it effects our health, our hearts, and our homes. We should know that the Body and Blood of Christ **Heals our Health**. Jesus began his public ministry by preaching, teaching, and healing. He healed people of blindness, deafness, lameness and of many other conditions. Jesus still heals people today. We should know that the Body and Blood of Christ Heals our Hearts. People are truly hurting today. They are hurting from many wounds from many different sources. The body of Christ heals the wounds that we have. Trust him today. We should know that the Body and Blood of Christ **Heals our Homes**. There is no sweeter taste than going to Confession and then consuming our Lord in the Eucharist. This is such an awesome feeling. Lives are transformed in these moments. But most of all, our families and our home lives can be transformed. Today is the day to reestablish your true belief in the Real Presence of our Lord in the Eucharist.




