From the desk of Fr. Lewis

This week, we celebrate the great feast of Pentecost. The Holy Spirit descends upon the Apostles and Mary, breathing new life into the Church. At St. Peter's Basilica, there is a window that has an image of the Holy Spirit. A golden light enters through the window because it is made of porphyry, a yellow stone. (Our yellow windows at St. Philip are a similar hue.) As the light streams into the basilica, it's taken up by the statues, the gold leafing, the marble, and the mosaics. In a way, it appears that everything comes from this one source of light.

That window points to our belief that all the life in the Church comes from one source: the Holy Spirit poured upon us at Pentecost. May the Spirit descend upon us - and may the life of the Church flow ever more abundantly into our lives and our world.
