

A Note from your Pastor

I was not born yet when Pope Pius VI called the Ordinary Jubilee in 1975. My first experience of the Jubilee was in 2000. It was that year when I finally decided to move to Los Angeles. I felt like Abraham being called out of Ur to Canaan, the Promised Land. Back then, and it is probably true for most Filipinos, America is the land of milk and honey; our Promised Land. Although I lived in Guam (which is an American territory), I actually felt that it was just an extension of the Philippines because of their proximity, plus I think about a third of the people in Guam are Filipinos. Mainland America is the Promised Land!

Indeed, on my first experience of the Jubilee, something life-changing happened.

Then, my second experience of the Jubilee was the Extraordinary Jubilee called by Pope Francis from December 8, 2015 to November 20, 2016. Again, something great happened to me. I went on a pilgrimage to the tomb of St. Kateri Tekakwitha and to the Oratory of St. Joseph, both in Montreal. But, the biggest "pilgrimage" that happened was the ontological change that occurred to me when I got ordained to the sacred priesthood. I went from being an ordinary person to being a priest. Like baptism, a character was imprinted in my soul.

Now, we are celebrating another Jubilee year, and I am so excited to receive the graces and indulgences attached to it. I have planned pilgrimages (parish pilgrimage to the Basilica in a few weeks, my solo pilgrimage to visit the tomb of St. Philip the Apostle next month, and another group pilgrimage to visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico in October). I believe that something great is about to happen from this pilgrimages.

I hope that like me, you are excited and eager to receive the graces of the Jubilee Year and be thankful to God. I hope that you will do a pilgrimage (with us or by yourself). If doing a pilgrimage is difficult, just remember the other ways to experience the Ordinary Jubilee Year 2025 and be a pilgrim of hope.

Fast and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.
