

DEAR PARISHIONERS,

Happy Mother's Day: On behalf of the Resurrection Staff, Pastoral Council and leadership people, I wish all of our moms God's blessings for a Happy Mother's Day.

As a kid growing up on the farm we would often times listen to the AM Radio station out of Cedar Rapids, 600 WMT. Sunday mornings would feature the program, "Variety Time" with Leo Greco playing all sorts of requests in honor of birthdays and anniversaries.
