**DEAR PARISHIONERS,**

Happy Mother's Day: On behalf of the Resurrection Staff, Pastoral Council and leadership people, I wish all of our moms God's blessings for a Happy Mother's Day.

As a kid growing up on the farm we would often times listen to the AM Radio station out of Cedar Rapids, 600 WMT. Sunday mornings would feature the program, "Variety Time" with Leo Greco playing all sorts of requests in honor of birthdays and anniversaries. On Mother's Day, I remember a song sung by Eddie Arnold that filled the airwaves on that particular Sunday morning. I recall the following song, "MOTHER – A Word that Means the World to Me."

With some nostalgia regarding the older days of radio and with loving sentiment still for my own mother today, I present the lyrics from that song for your reflection as you think of and pray for your own mothers on this day.
