**DEAR PARISHIONERS,****My Farewell Message to the People of God in the Resurrection Parish**

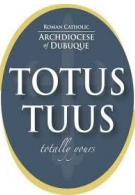

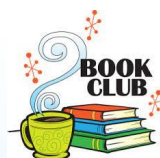
