| | Security Updates – Denis Wagner and Mike Kelly "attended" a webinar put on by federal officials and learned that Resurrection is doing a good job based on the size of our parish, other than the recommended practice of locking the doors. Travis advised that the best practice would be to have people practice exiting, knowing where exits and other resources are, rather than just hearing about them and/or watching a video. | | |
| | Arch One – Jeff S. talked to the pastoral council about the current archdiocesan special appeal (different than a capital campaign). As much burden as possible has been taken off parishes and is being handled by the archdiocese, to help maintain a positive relationship. Parishes are still allowed to raise their own funds during Arch One, and no arbitrary goal for each parish were established. The archdiocese doesn't want parishes to sacrifice existing activities. Goals of this special appeal are priest retirement (\$15m), seminary education (\$15m), immigration legal services (\$7m), and Cathedral repairs (\$11m). Note that this is not criminal law, and they provide services to legal immigrants and refugees. The Cathedral is the mother church for the archdiocese. At about 160 years old, it needs a lot of work. Primary problems include leaks in the roof and water running down the bluff and entering the lower level of the building. Resurrection is in the third group of parishes to start, with the first being a small test group and the second being those south of Hwy. 20. Starting next weekend, there will be an increase in information directed to Resurrection and parishioners, hoping to increase interest in the appeal. The focus on the third group will last eight weeks. Families are asked to donate over a 5-year pledge period, again without sacrificing what they are doing locally. | | |
