PASTOR'S REPORT	SCHOOL UPDATE – Father shared that Holy Family would like to use the south side of our school property for St. Columbkille's students when their renovations begin. In return for using the building, Holy Family will reduce the assessment for Resurrection by ten percent. Father shared that the funds from that reduction will be allocated to bringing down the south portion at some future point and possibly the construction of a new entry area to the school. Father is putting together a five-year plan. Father shared that the assessment to Holy Family could be decreased to twenty percent.
