When choosing a Confirmation name, you should reflect on the following:

- 1) **Reflect on your values.** Which virtues do you most admire? Courage? Compassion? Wisdom? Let these guide your search for saints who embodied these qualities.
- 2) **Research saints with shared interests.** Are you passionate about music? Consider Saint Cecilia. Do you love animals? Look to Saint Francis of Assisi. If you are drawn to education, read more about Saint John Baptist de La Salle or Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton.
- 3) **Consider family heritage**. Many young people choose to honor their cultural background by choosing a saint that is significant to their family's heritage.
- 4) **Pray for guidance.** Ask the Holy Spirit to help you recognize which saint you feel a connection with. Prayer can open our hearts to God's guidance.
- 5) **Read their stories.** Do a deep dive into how these holy men and women lived, struggled, and triumphed in faith.
- 6) **Seek counsel from trusted mentors.** Talk to your parents, godparents, sponsor, or your priest. Sharing your reflections and potential choices with them can provide valuable insights and help you discern the best fit. They may offer perspectives you haven't considered and help you solidify your decision.
