**K O F C DONATION:** As mentioned in last weekend's bulletin, the Knights are pleased to report that they have collected 1,012 pounds of food that has been given to our St. Ann Food Shelf to help community members in need in their fiscal/fraternal year 2021-2022! This donation has gone a very long way to help those among us experiencing food insecurity.

**LADIES OF ST. ANN DONATIONS:** Since the Ladies of St. Ann have not yet been able to host/hold funeral meals in the parish hall since the beginning of the pandemic, they have turned their energies into making donations to the Food Shelf. Understanding the difficult choices many families have to make between buying food for their tables or gas for their cars, LOSA first purchased gas cards that were given to patrons in need. Next, they put together "spring cleaning baskets" that contained some basic items for people to help take care of those yearly cleaning tasks in their homes. And, most recently, they created a "bbq basket" for summer get togethers that included baked beans, condiments, pickles, salsa, a grill tray & brush, aluminum foil, festive paper plates & napkins, and an American Flag too! Thank you to the ladies for their creativity and caring for our community members in need.

**FOOD SHELF DONATIONS AND NEW IDEAS!** The Food Shelf has received many generous donations of cash as well over the last months. Thus, we have been able to do some "extra" things as well in addition to the food & toiletry bags regularly given out.
