BABY BOTTLE CAMPAIGN: Mother's Day began our annual Baby Bottle Campaign with Aspire Now. Please give the card attached to the bottle to anyone you think could use their services. Their mobile clinic "Laura" is in St. Albans as well as in Chittenden County to minister where needed. Aspire Now is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization that offers all services free of charge while receiving no federal or state funding.
