## BISHOP'S APPEAL AND FOUNDER'S DAY OF

**GIVING:** This week's update shows that we are now at 79% of our goal of \$41,252! The overall campaign is at 62% of goal, up 16% from this same time last year.

Also, July 29th is called the "*Founder's Day of Giving*" in honor of the creation of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Burlington in 1853, under the leader of our first bishop, Louis de Goesbriand. This year, the Vermont Catholic Community Foundation has provided a \$10,000 matching grant for all donations made to the Bishop's Annual Appeal on Founder's Day, next Saturday, July 29, until fulfilled.
