STATIONS OF THE CROSS: Stations of the Cross will be held every Thursday during Lent at 5:00PM with Mass immediately following.

THE CHRISM MASS: The Chrism Mass will be held on Monday, March 25th at 11:00am at the Cathedral of Saint Joseph in Burlington. At this special Mass celebrated by Archbishop Coyne, the Oil of Chrism is consecrated, the Oils of the Catechumens and the Sick are blessed, and the priests within the Diocese of Burlington recommit themselves to the Priesthood of Jesus Christ. Free parking is available along Elmwood Avenue and pay lots/garages are near the Cathedral. Carpooling is highly encouraged.
