

#### **WELCOME BACK!**

Under the new state guidelines, Parishes may reopen for weekend Masses with a congregation not to exceed <u>100</u> people. In our Parish...

WEEKEND MASSES will be celebrated on Saturday at 5:00 p.m., and on Sunday at 10:30 a.m., with a Spanish Mass at 1:30 p.m. For those unable to attend the Mass a video of the Mass is posted on our Parish website.

<u>DAILY MASS</u> will be celebrated Monday through Friday, at 8:00 a.m., and Saturday, at 8:30 a.m., in the Church Chapel.

<u>BAPTISMS</u> are now permitted in our churches. There are specific guidelines we have to follow, due to the pandemic. If you are interested in having your baby baptized, please call the Parish Office.

<u>CONFESSIONS</u> are heard on Saturday mornings, from 11:00 a.m. until noon, in the Church Chapel.

For your safety, all those attending any services must wear a mask. All social distancing and sanitizing guidelines will be followed.

#### **Please Note:**

The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass will remain in effect until further notice. No one is required to participate in Mass at this time. While the obligation to attend Mass is dispensed, the faithful who are not able to attend Mass in the Church are to keep the Lord's Day holy by some other means. For example, they should tune in to a livestreamed Mass, read and reflect on Sacred Scripture, pray the rosary, or some other devotion.

When we think of being good stewards, we may think that God is asking too much of us when He calls us to generously share our time, talent, and treasure. However, we must remember that we are not "owners" of anything, we are merely "stewards" of the gifts God has given us. All He is asking is that we give back a small portion, in gratitude, of what He has already given to us.

#### SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

It has long been a Catholic understanding that when circumstances prevent one from receiving Holy Communion, it is possible to make an *Act of Spiritual Communion* which is a source of grace. *Spiritual Communion* means uniting one's self in prayer with Christ's sacrifice and worshiping Him in His Body and Blood. The most common reason for making an *Act of Spiritual Communion* is when a person cannot attend Mass, as is still the case for many, during this pandemic.

For all who are unable to receive the Holy Eucharist in person, consider this special prayer:

### **Spiritual Communion Prayer**

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things and I desire to receive You in my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there, and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

#### **NEW JERSEY SAFE HAVEN LAW**

Under the NJ Safe Haven Infant Protection Act, a person may give up an unwanted infant anonymously. The purpose of Safe Haven is to protect unwanted babies from being hurt or killed from unsafe abandonment. A distressed parent who is unable to care for an infant can give up custody of a baby less than 30 days old safely, legally, and anonymously. All that is required is that the baby be brought to any hospital emergency room, police station, fire station, ambulance, first aid and rescue squads in New Jersey that are staffed 24 hours a day, seven days a week. As long as the child shows no signs of intentional abuse, no name or other information is required. The Parent can call the Safe Haven Hotline, at 1-877-839-2339, and get the address and directions for any hospital emergency room, police station, firs station, ambulance, first aid, and rescue squad in the state.


