
Saint Joseph 'Feast Day Raffle'






Online applications must be completed (including all required documentation) by no later than March 31, 2022. Applications are available in English and Spanish.

The seven sacraments of the Catholic Church are visible signs that celebrate what we believe about God and God's Church. They give God's grace to the Church and are a source of God's life for us.

Sacramentals are objects the Church considers sacred or holy because they prepare us to receive and work with the grace of the sacraments to bring us closer to God (see the Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1677).


