




Our readings are taken from the feast of the Ascension. There is no longer the sixth Sunday in Easter as a Sunday observance.

# PREP

St. Joseph Church  
Parish Religious Education Program

Registration for the 2022-2023 Parish Religious Education Program year is open. This year, we are excited that we are able to accept payments by credit and debit cards. Re-registration Forms have been sent home with students and are also available at the PREP and Parish Offices, on the counter in the narthex and online. The St. Joseph Parish Religious Education Program welcomes children in grades 1 through 8 who wish to prepare for and receive the sacraments of 1<sup>st</sup> Holy Communion and Confirmation. As parents are the first teachers of the faith, we rely on them to enhance what is taught in their child's weekly religious education class.

Most important in our PREP are the volunteer catechists who teach our classes. These dedicated men and women generously give of their time and talent each week and without them, there would be no PREP!

Our catechists also assist parents, who are the primary educators of the faith, in preparing their children to not only receive the sacraments of First Penance, First Holy Communion and Confirmation, but also in teaching them more about their faith.

The PREP year consists of weekly hour-and-a-half classes for students from 6 to 12 years old. We also offer classes for high-school-age students who have not yet received their sacraments.

Advent and Lenten confessions give our students in grades 3 through 8, an opportunity to reflect on those things that they have done well and a chance to talk with the priest about the things on which they still need to work.

During the weeks leading up to Thanksgiving, students and their families donate food items to the Saint Joseph Food Pantry and during Lent, they donate the money that they have saved from "giving up something for Lent" to the Missionary Childhood Association.

Our Children's and Family Masses, include PREP students as well as students from Saint Joseph Grade School. At these Masses, students participate in the Mass by doing the readings, Intercessions and bringing the gifts to the altar. During the 5 p.m. Christmas Eve Mass, the children re-enact the first Christmas with Mary and Joseph, the angels and wise men.





### GOOD POPE JOHN



June 3 we will remember the anniversary of the death of St. Pope John XXIII. This pope came from very humble beginnings. He was born Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli in 1881 in Bergamo, Italy, one of thirteen children. His family was so poor that Angelo would walk to school carrying his shoes so the leather wouldn't wear out.

Angelo served in World War I as a chaplain and often worked as a stretcher bearer for the Italian army. He worked in diplomatic missions and tried to create good relationships among Christians, Muslims, and Jews. In Italy he was the National Director of the Society for the Propagation of the Faith, and also taught at a seminary in Rome.

A month before he turned 78, Cardinal Roncalli was elected pope. He took the name John, after his father and the patron saint of Rome's cathedral, St. John Lateran.

As pope, John XXIII added to the number of cardinals in the college of cardinals. He wanted to include men from different countries and cultures. He convened the Second Vatican Council to examine the Church's role in the modern world. With all his duties as pope he still found time to visit hospitals, orphanages, and jails in the city. He often dressed in a simple priest's cassock and walked through the streets of Rome and talked with the people he met.


"Good Pope John," as he was called, died on June 3, 1963. He was beatified by Pope John Paul II in 2000. Pope Francis canonized him as a saint in 2014.

Let us pray that we can follow the example of this holy man. Let us work for peace and understanding among all people. Like "Good Pope John," may we walk among the poor and reach out our hands to those in need.


