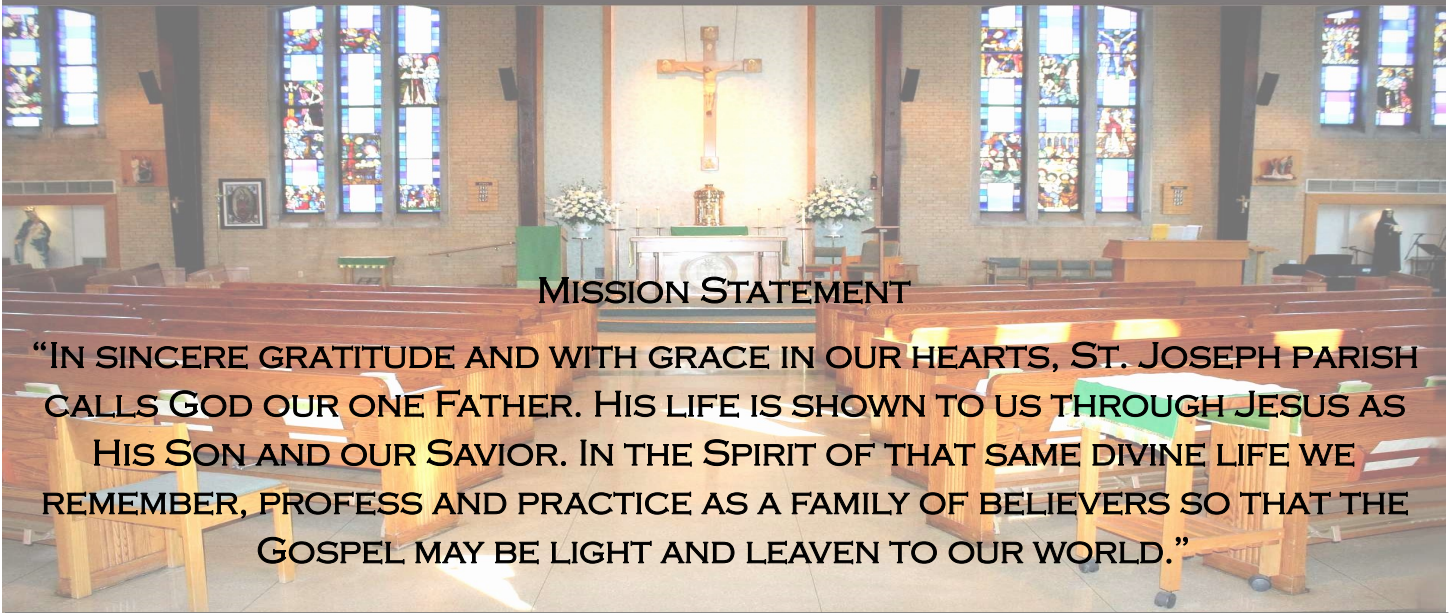

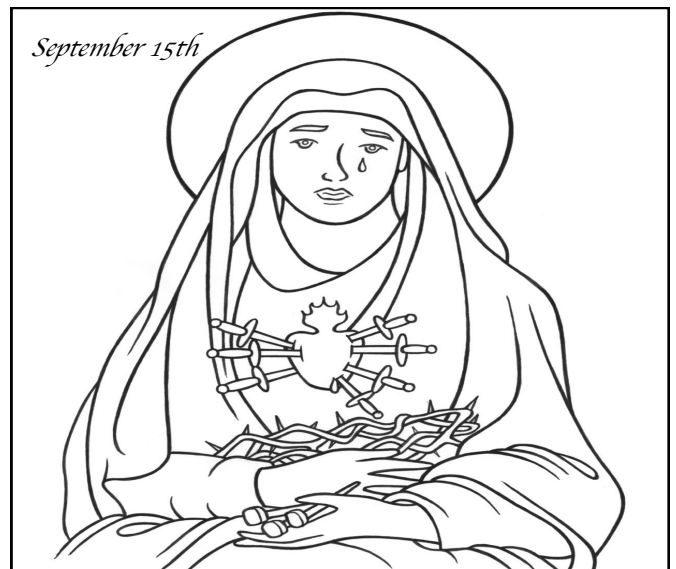
Feast Day: September 14

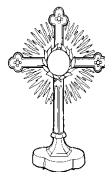
