



# Parish Pastoral Plan 2025/2026

Entering the newness of the hope inspired through our Jubilee observance, the theme for pastoral life amidst parish planning focuses on knowing and receiving the Holy Spirit.

In reflection on the apostle's words, "No one can say that Jesus is Lord except by the Holy Spirit." 1Cor 12, 31; we ask that our common efforts and sharing be directed toward embracing the Spirit's life. How is the Spirit manifesting a deeper joy in faith and service?

Placing this focus on our priorities of parish legacy, parish school and faith formation, parish outreach in charity, and parish missionary sharing, different initiatives are announced within the seasons of Ordinary Time, Advent/Christmas, Ordinary Time/Lent and Easter/Ordinary Time.

# **Ordinary Time:**

- 1. As the parish joins on Labor Day weekend and supports with the annual parish raffle, a special invitation is given to our seniors to be a 'St. Joseph Buddy' with our school students at monthly mass each First Friday at St. Joseph School.
- 2. Our parish/school plans the 250th anniversary of the first call to freedom for our nation with a special November Veteran's service to be held at Carteret Performing Arts Center.
- 3. Mittens, hats and scarves' drive is begun in the fall 2025 for donation to our food pantry ministry and the 'Bowl for Hunger' day in support of local food pantries is promoted for all to attend.
- 4. As part of Jubilee year 2025 fire, police, EMT and postal workers are gifted with home baked items as September celebrates the Blue Mass and 'Patriots' Day', also free seats are reserved for those who can join from these civil servants' groups on our diocesan pilgrimage, September 20.

### Advent/Christmas

- With the closing of the Jubilee Year, a special dedication is made for our church foyer anticipating the next 'Holy Door' welcome in 2050 and an album is prepared with parishioners' hopes and dreams for next 25 years.
- A Christmas tree fundraiser of lit trees is introduced at the school property with a tree lighting and community sponsors together with families each participating with individual tree dedications.
- 3. At Thanksgiving and Christmas our food pantry ministry encourages every parish family to qualify for a free turkey/ham from local supermarket and donate it in the spirit of charity.
- 4. Parish calendars for 2026 together with poinsettia plants are brought to those who are homebound and the youth Christmas carolers accompany these visits.
